

**MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
St. AMBROSE UNIVERSITY
AND
SOUTHEASTERN COMMUNITY COLLEGE HONORS PROGRAM**

PURPOSE:

This document constitutes an agreement between Saint Ambrose University and Southeastern Community College (SCC). The purpose of this agreement is to formalize an understanding of cooperation between the two institutions in order to assist Southeastern Community College honors students in their preparation for admission, and transfer to Saint Ambrose University Honors Program.

THE SCC HONORS PROGRAM:

The Southeastern College Honors Program (SCCHP) values academic scholarship and excellence. The Honors Program offers opportunities for advanced learning, innovative ideas, social and cultural experiences, community service, leadership, and personal development to the students who ask more of themselves, their instructors, and their education.

COMPLETION AND GRADUATION:

To be recognized as an SCC Honors Program graduate, a student must complete the following:

- A. Honors coursework that fulfills 12 credits of the SCC general education course requirements from a combination of:
 - Communications
 - Humanities
 - Social Science
 - Math & Science
 - Cultural Awareness
- B. Maintain a 3.5 GPA
- C. Complete an Honors Project
- D. Attend a professional conference/event

FORMAL ACCEPTANCE:

Southeastern Community College formally accepts the Honors Articulation Agreement between Southeastern Community College Honors Program (SCCHP) and Saint Ambrose University as specified above.

IMPLEMENTATION AND REVIEW:

Implementation of this Agreement is scheduled for September, 2019 and is subject to review as substantive changes in the two honors programs may warrant.
