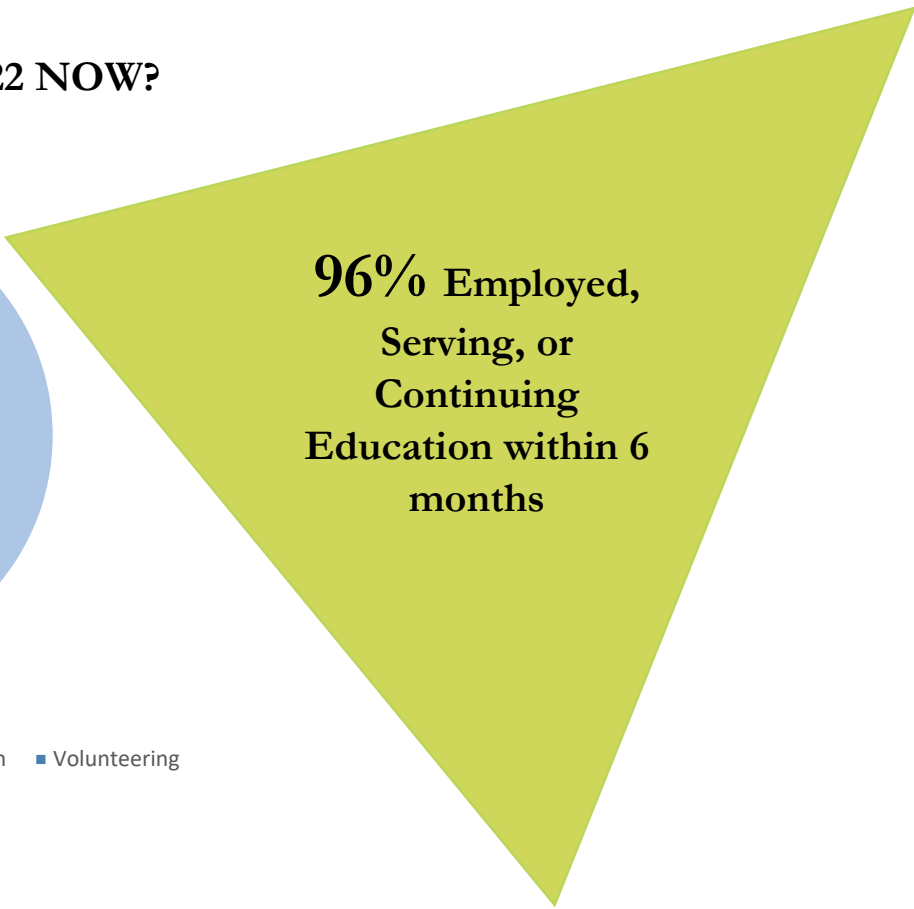
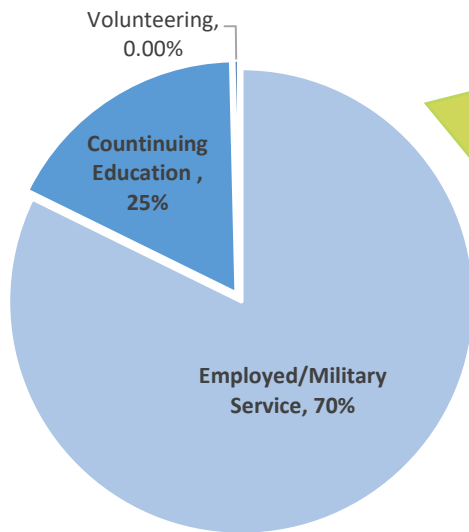


About the Survey: The Class of 2022 First Destination Survey, conducted by the St. Ambrose University Academic and Career Planning Center and the St. Ambrose Office of Institutional Research, was completed in November 2022. The survey includes undergraduate students who graduated between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022 per the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) standards and protocols for graduate student outcomes. Graduating seniors were contacted 1 month prior to graduation, 3 months after graduation, and 6 months after graduation by email, with repeated follow-up phone calls into November 2022. Of the 537 students who make up this reporting class, we were able to obtain employment information on 378 (70.4%). *Note: The COVID-19 pandemic greatly impacted the response rate and employment rate of this class.*

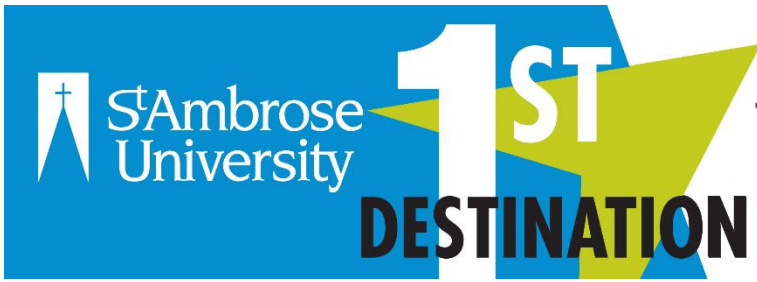
WHERE IS THE CLASS OF 2022 NOW?



■ Employed/Military Service ■ Countinuing Education ■ Volunteering

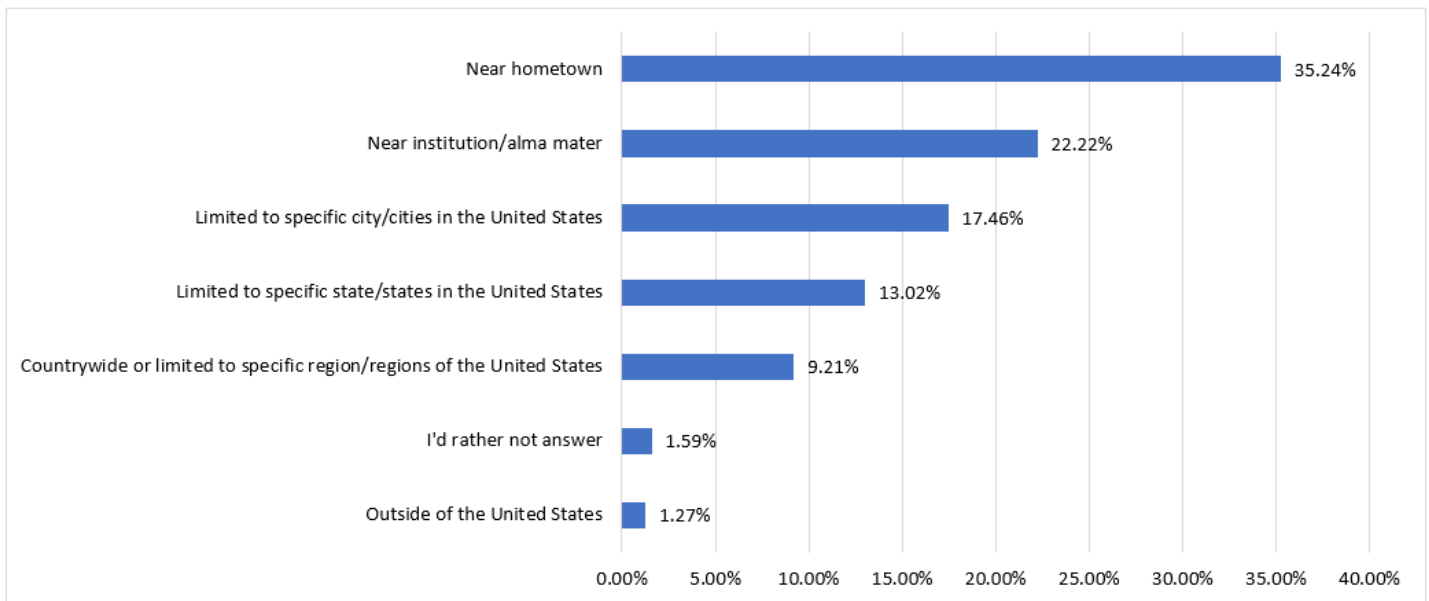

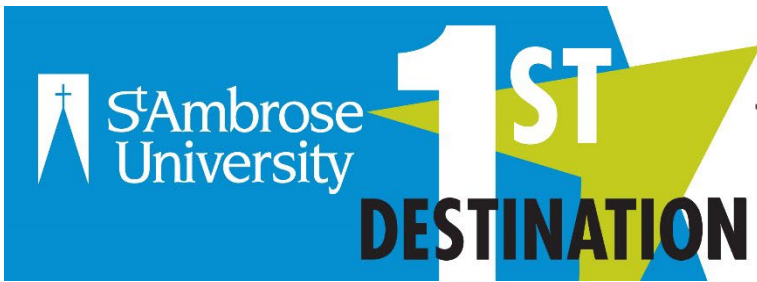
WHERE ARE THEY WORKING?

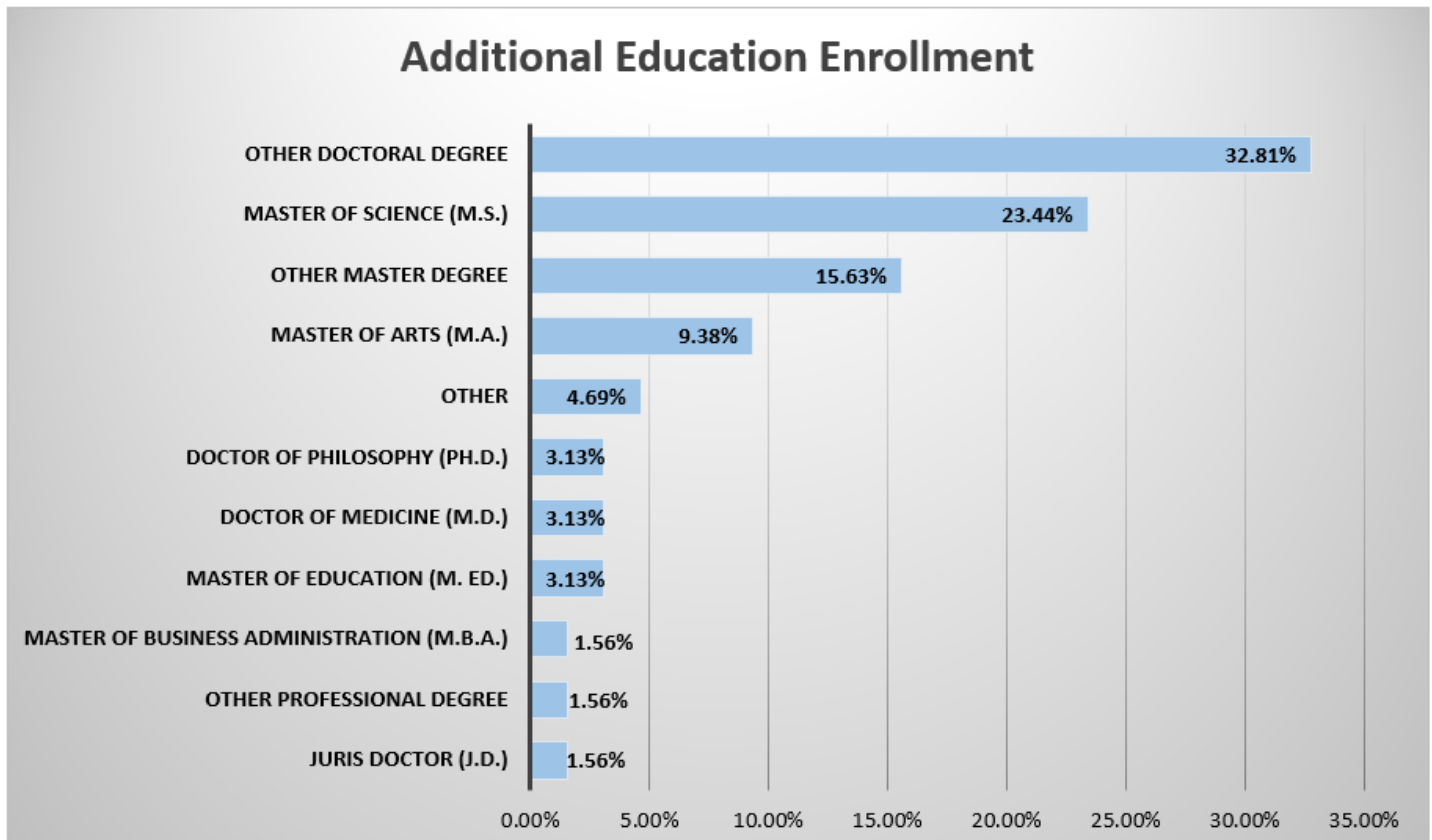

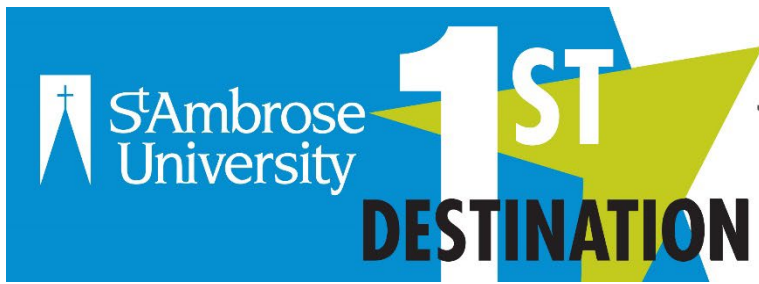


Where are they studying?

- 2% Tennessee

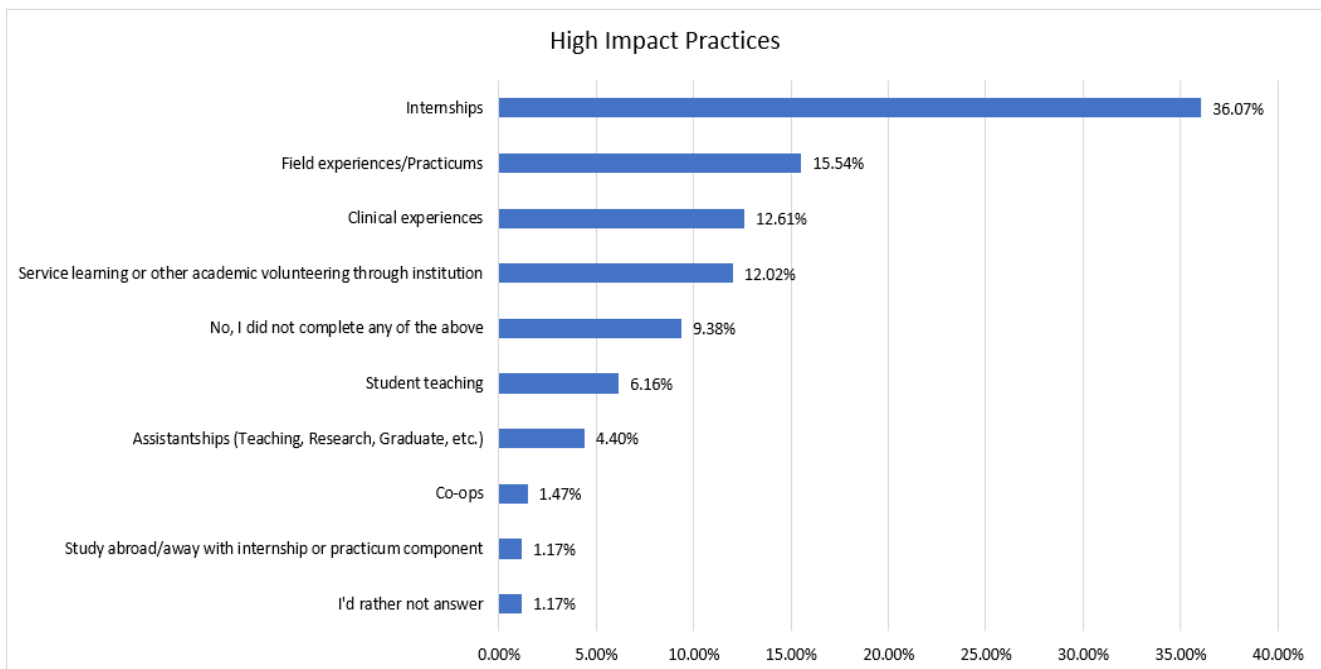

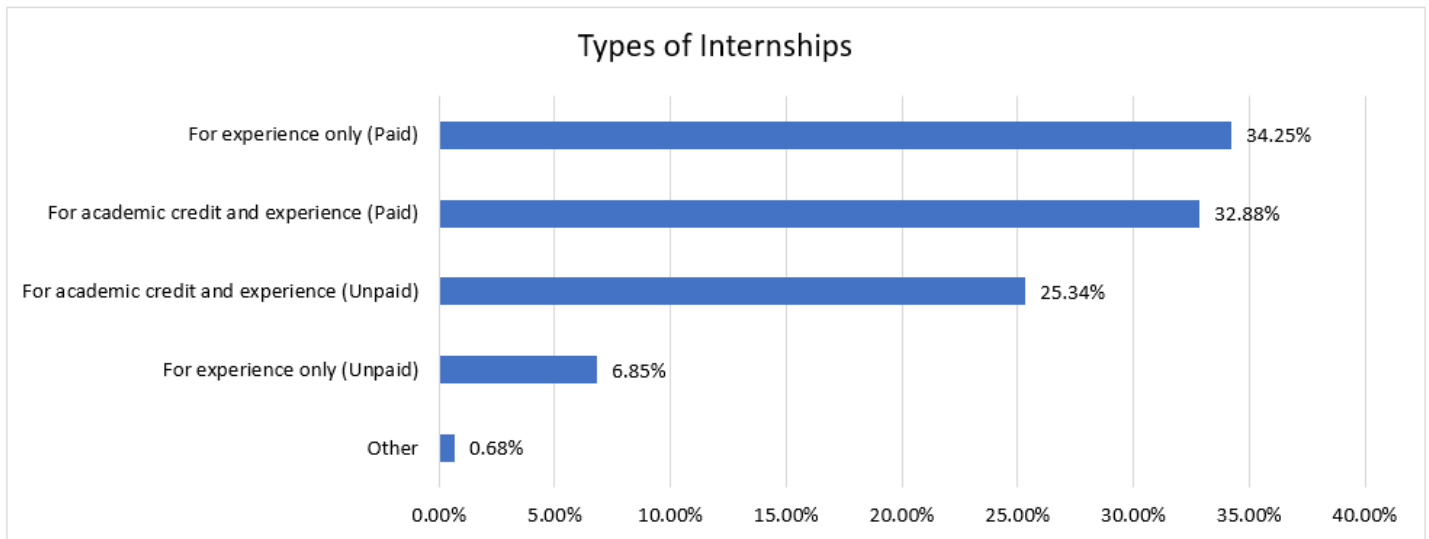
EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

- Of those who responded to this question on the survey (218 out of 374), 79% participated in an internship, clinical, field experience, student teaching, practicum, or study abroad with internship.



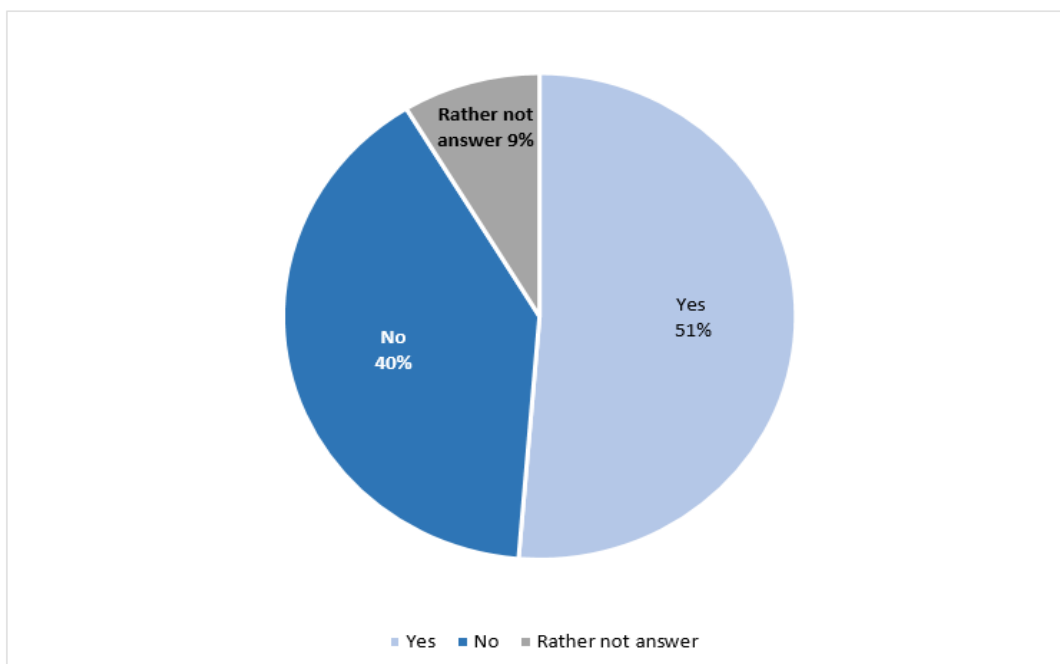
NUMBER OF INTERNSHIPS COMPLETED
